



Playing Guidelines

1 What is Super5 and Super5 PLUS Xpress?

Super5 Xpress is a product under the National Lottery Xpress brand. Super5 Xpress allows players to participate with a randomly issued quick pick ticket of five (5) numbers from a total pool of forty-five (45) numbers and is available for purchase from select retailers.

A first prize category is won when matching five (5) numbers, while secondary and tertiary prize categories are won by matching four (4) or three (3) numbers, respectively. Super5 Xpress tickets with five (5) quick pick numbers has a minimum participation cost of €2.

Super5 PLUS Xpress enables players to participate in a second draw with their original randomly issued Super5 Xpress quick pick ticket of five (5) numbers. Super5 PLUS Xpress is played with the original quick pick numbers randomly selected for the Super5 Xpress game. A maximum jackpot of €100,000 is won when matching five (5) numbers. If four (4) or three (3) numbers are matched, the second or third category prizes are won, respectively.

Super5 PLUS Xpress tickets are bought in conjunction with the Super5 Xpress tickets and cost an additional €1 for a minimum participation in the game.

2 Super5 Xpress Ticket Description

The ticket is the unique valid document for winning prizes. The following is an illustration that represents a visual of the Super5 Xpress ticket, including the information displayed on the ticket.

- POS Barcode.
- Game logo and QR code linking to the National Lottery Xpress website.
- Draw date in which the ticket is participating.
- Validity of the ticket.
- Draw Number and Serial Number.
- Playing Board(s), including: Numbers chosen, Quick Pick feature and Number of Combinations.
- Super5 PLUS participation (Yes/No).
- Price of the ticket.
- Advertising Message.
- Ticket Details: Chainhead, Clerk, Terminal and Security Code Number.
- Date and Time of purchase.
- Serial Number and Barcode.

It is the player's entire responsibility to ensure that the selections printed on the ticket are correct and in line with the ones requested.

3 How Super5 Xpress and Super5 PLUS Xpress is Played

3.1 Simple Column Quick Pick

A Quick Pick is a fully automatic number selection method whereby the terminal generates all the numbers according to the game rules.

For the Super5 Xpress game, a simple column is defined as one combination of five (5) numbers selected randomly by the terminal.

For the Super5 PLUS Xpress game, the same set of numbers randomly selected to participate in the Super5 Xpress game, are also valid for the second draw.

The basic column price for playing Super5 Xpress is €2.00.

3.2 Different Playing Methods

The terminal allows the player to include different playing methods on one ticket. For example, on the same ticket, the player can play a Simple Column in the first board, i.e., generating five (5) numbers.

4 Super5 and Super5 PLUS Draws

4.1 When can Super5 Xpress be Played?

Players can play Super5 Xpress from Monday to Sunday during the allowed playing hours, excluding the draw break. On Wednesdays and Fridays, tickets can be bought until 20:00hrs as participation is allowed until 30 minutes before the draw time.

The Super5 and Super5 PLUS draws are conducted every Wednesday and Friday. The draws are broadcast live on TV, with the live stream and recorded draws also available on the National Lottery website.

4.2 How is the Draw Conducted?

The Super5 and Super5 PLUS draws are held in the presence of:

- i. A representative of the Authority
- ii. A Notary Public

The Notary Public, who will be present at the draw, will draw up and sign a record of the proceedings, which are entered in a register kept for that purpose.

4.3 Consecutive Draws

The player is given the choice to participate with the same set of numbers in more than one (1) draw by choosing to participate with 'CONSECUTIVE DRAWS'.

The player has the possibility to participate in up to a maximum of sixty (60) consecutive draws on one single quick pick ticket.

5 Cost of Entry in Super5 Xpress and Super5 PLUS Xpress

The price for one (1) Simple Column Quick Pick with five (5) numbers for Super5 Xpress is €2.00. The fixed price for Super5 PLUS Xpress is of €1.00 per column created.

The table below presents the number of Simple Columns created per Playing Board for the possible number of combinations according to the selected numbers in one Playing Board in Super5 Xpress and the respective cost of entry for the mentioned combinations.

6 Super5 Xpress and Super5 PLUS Xpress Prizes

6.1 Winning Categories of Super5 Xpress and Super5 PLUS Xpress

To win in Super5 Xpress and Super5 PLUS Xpress, the player must match the selected numbers with the drawn numbers. The more numbers the player plays, the greater the winning probabilities.

Following is a table showing the corresponding odds for each Winning Category in the Super5 Xpress game and the Super5 PLUS Xpress game.

6.2 Distribution of Prizes in Super5 Xpress

The prize money in a Super5 draw is dependent on the sales and is divided among the winners as per the table below.

Winning Categories	Prize
1st Category	46.3% of the prize pool
2nd Category	18.2% of the prize pool
3rd Category	35.5% of the prize pool

If a winner is not found in any winning category, the corresponding amount is transferred to the same category of the next draw.

National Lottery plc. guarantees a minimum amount of €250,000 for the first winning category. If there is no Jackpot winner, the minimum guaranteed prize for the first category, for the next draw, is automatically increased pro-rata according to sales with a minimum €25,000 weekly increase across all draws.

6.3 Distribution of Prizes in Super5 PLUS Xpress

The Super5 PLUS prize pool for winners is 45% of the current draw total sales. The distribution of prizes can be found in the table below.

Winning Categories	Prize
1st Category	11% of the prize pool
2nd Category	18.2% of the prize pool
3rd Category	70.8% of the prize pool

If a winner is not found in any winning category, the respective prize fund is added to the reserve pool.

National Lottery plc. guarantees a minimum winning amount of €100,000 for the first winning category. If, in any draw, there is more than one (1) simple column winning for the first winning category, then the prize is split according to the number of winning columns.
